REFUNDS/CANCELLATIONS: All cancellation requests must be in writing. Credits for residents canceling or checking out after the start of intersession will be prorated by the day of actual checkout. Cancellations should be submitted along with a copy of your Registration form received upon checking out. Be sure to include the words “WINTER CANCELLATION” on your cancellation request.

Please note that only residents with valid Fall 2009 and Spring 2010 room assignments are eligible for Winter Intersession Housing.
