



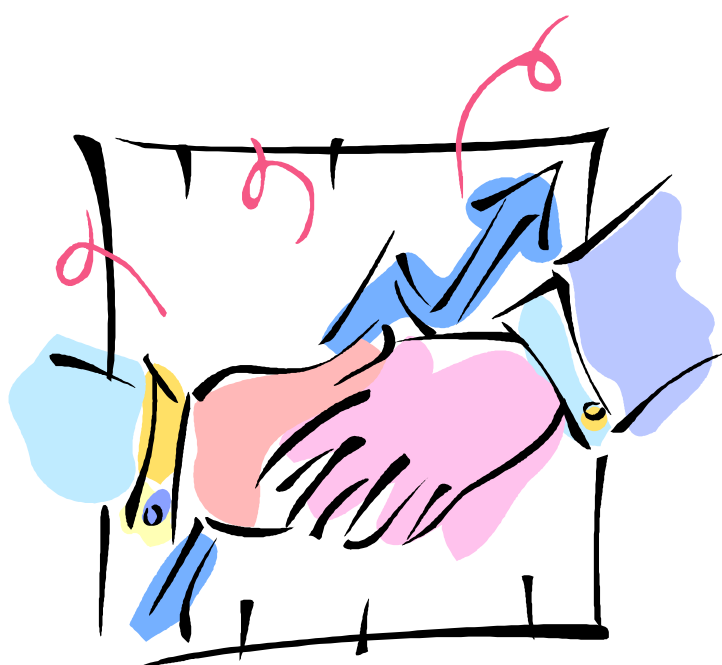

Dr. Bauman is this year's recipient of the NASPA Region II Scott Goodnight Award and will be honored at this year's annual NASPA Region II Conference in June 2010. The Scott Goodnight Award is given to a Senior Student Affairs Professional who has demonstrated sustained professional service in student affairs work, high-level competency in administrative skills, innovative response in meeting students' varied and emerging needs, effectiveness in developing junior staff members, and leadership in community and university affairs. This award recipient must also have earned stature among and support of students, faculty, and fellow administrators on his or her campus and made significant contributions to the field through publications or professional involvement.

Dr. Bauman has worked at Stony Brook since 1981 having served as the Director of Residence Life and most recently as the Assistant Vice President for Campus Residences. Dr. Bauman is instrumental in developing and implementing the on-going multi-million dollar renovation program for Stony Brook's Residence Halls, was a key member of the Undergraduate College Planning Team, is one of the founders and directs the campus' Aids Peer Education Program, and has taken the lead in the development and implementation of the Student Employment Learning Outcome (SELO) initiative at Stony Brook.

As the Region II recipient of the Scott Goodnight Award, Dr. Bauman is also one of the finalists for the National Scott Goodnight Award given each year at the NASPA National Conference!
